



TWIGS Acting Audition Requirements SY 26/27

Thank you for your interest in the TWIGS Acting Program!

Baltimore City residents entering the 5th–8th grade in School Year 2026/2027 may audition for the TWIGS Acting Program. **No former experience or training is required for the Acting Audition!**

Acting Program auditions will be held **April 27– April 30, 2026** at Baltimore School for the Arts, 712 Cathedral Street, 21201.

Auditions will be held by appointment only. **All applicants must have submitted an online application by Friday, April 3rd in order to receive an appointment.** Each student's audition appointment day and time will be emailed to the parent/ guardian email who completed the audition application no later than Tuesday, April 14th, 2026.

TWIGS Acting Audition Requirements:

Students applying for the Acting program must present a **monologue** (a speech delivered by one actor in a play) **of 1-2 minutes in length, or a poem of 1 minute in length.** The monologue or poem must be from a known and published play, and NOT FROM A FILM OR MOVIE.

The monologue or poem presented should be memorized. A public address, speech, or self written monologue or poem should not be used. Each student will be asked to perform the monologue or poem individually in front of faculty from our Acting department. Students may be asked a few questions about their interest in acting and joining TWIGS. Examples and suggested monologues are attached [here](#).
