



TWIGS Stage Design and Production (SDP) Audition Requirements SY 26/27

Thank you for your interest in the TWIGS SDP Program!

Do you like to create, make things, tell stories, problem solve, and work collaboratively in a group or team?

Baltimore City residents entering the 5th–8th grade in School Year 2026/2027 may audition for the TWIGS SDP Program. **No former experience or training is required for the SDP Audition!**

Stage Design & Production Program auditions will be held during Audition Week May 27th 2025 through June 2, 2025 at the Baltimore School for the Arts, 712 Cathedral Street, 21201.

Auditions will be held by appointment only. **All applicants must have submitted an online application by Friday, April 3rd in order to receive an appointment.** Each student's audition appointment day and time will be emailed to the parent/guardian email who completed the audition application no later than Tuesday, April 14th, 2026.

Stage Design & Production (SDP) Audition Requirements:

Prior to the audition all applicants are required to prepare 3–5 examples of work (drawings, paintings, collages, photographs, craft projects) that show their creativity.

All applicants must bring their work samples to their in-person audition appointment at the Baltimore School for the Arts. They must bring their original artwork to the audition (not copies). They will take their work samples home with them.

During the in-person audition, students should be prepared to discuss their work samples and their interest in SDP individually with faculty. They may

also participate in a group activity led by faculty. Any experience working on performances (plays, concerts, dance shows) may be included in the discussion, but ***previous experience is not required***. If you have any questions, email us at twigs@bsfa.org
